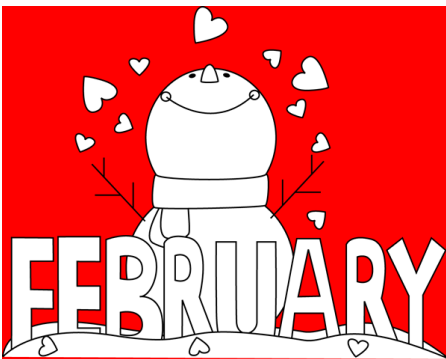

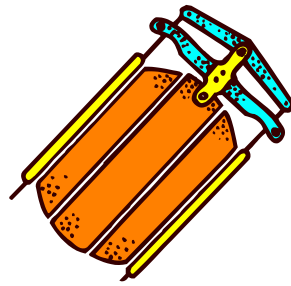

DUMPSTER ENCLOSURES

The dumpster enclosures are incurring significant amounts of trash inappropriate per Waste Management policy. Waste Management cannot collect when there is so much trash on TOP of the dumpster lids, so much trash in the center areas that walking is impossible, and so much trash that the exterior of the enclosure is encapsulated with trash.

Yard waste, electronic items, appliances, and furniture are **NOT ALLOWED** in any dumpster. The recycle bins must only contain trash as per the lids' recommendations.

The trash you are allowed to properly dispose of must be flattened or broken down whenever possible to help with space. Georgetown pays a large amount of your dues to keep Georgetown clean. Let's help keep costs down and follow policy.

CURB SIDE YARD WASTE PICK UP

For those residents who are still raking leaves or cleaning up their backyards, yard waste pick-up will continue throughout the winter on each Monday. Or if you prefer, you may take yard waste to the shop area and leave at the sign indicating "Yard Waste".
