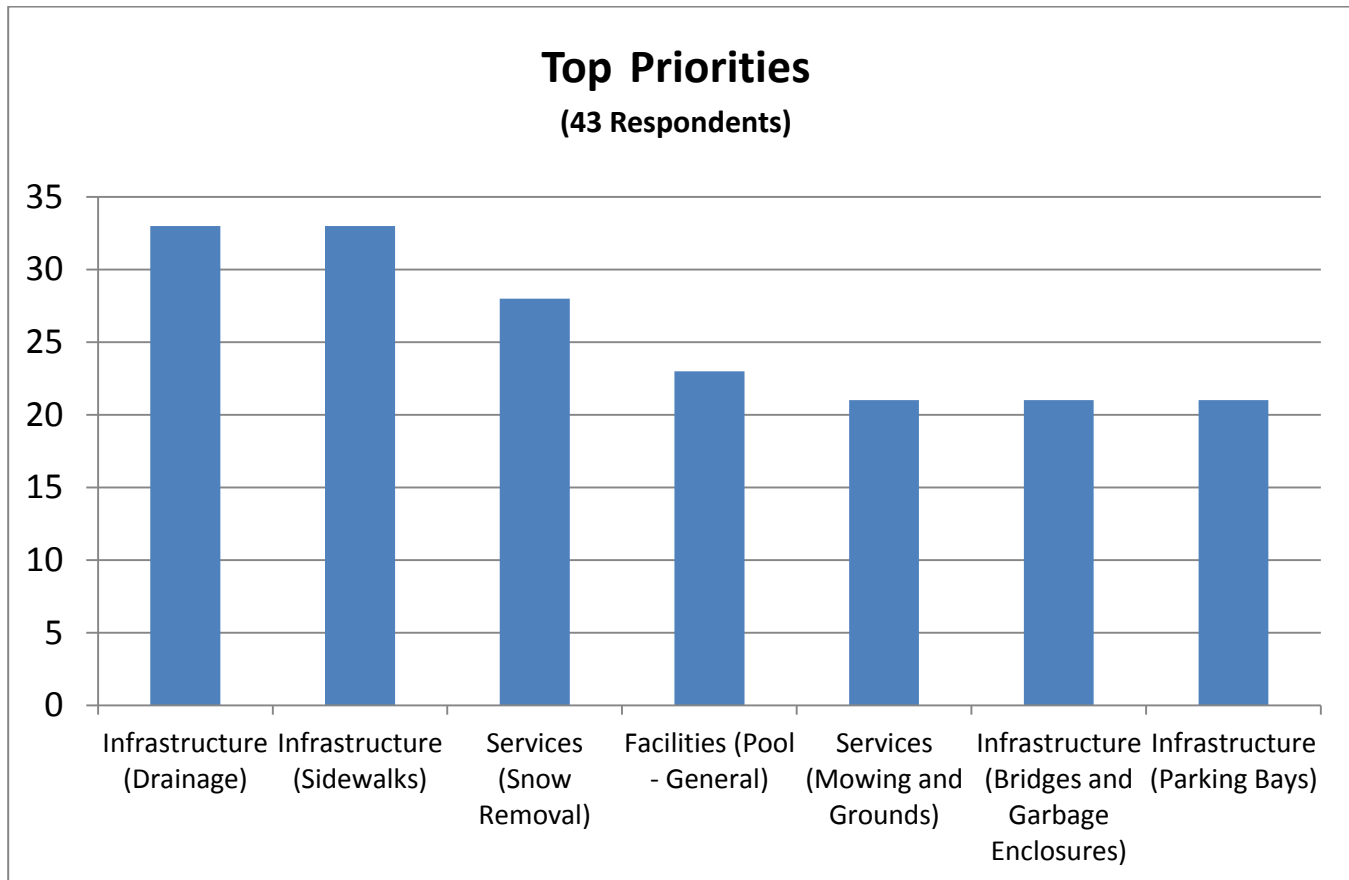


Priority Survey Summary

In September, 2014, the Vision Committee distributed a Priority Survey. This survey asked residents to prioritize a list of facilities and services and to indicate whether or not they would be willing to pay an increase in fees to provide the service or to maintain the facility. A total of 52 surveys were returned. Nine of these were incorrectly filled out, so the data was not useful. Based on the remaining 43 surveys, the top 7 priorities for both residents who are willing to pay an increase in fees and those who are not willing to pay an increase, are shown on the chart below.



The comments written on the surveys focused on the upkeep of the current facilities and services, not on improvements by adding additional facilities. The comments for Snow Removal mostly involved providing “timely” snow removal. The comments for Mowing were mixed, some indicating that mowing happened too much, others indicating that it did not happen often enough. There were additional comments about the need for tree trimming and the desire for more shade trees in the common areas. Sunken sidewalks and parking bays were also noted as needing repair.
